# Congratulation Adam Herman on your recent retirement and thank you for your 33 years of service!

Adam has been a part of the Lacombe community since 1987 and graduated from LCHS in 1991. He was an Artillery Cadet and served as a Reservist in Red Deer before being deployed. Adam's mother, Audrey Herman, currently resides in Lacombe.

The details of his many postings and tours of duty are listed below.

MWO HERMAN'S SERVICE TO CANADA STARTED WITH HIS ENROLLMENT IN THE PRIMARY RESERVES IN 1990. OVER THE NEXT 5 YEARS, HE DEPLOYED AS A PEACEKEEPER TO CYPRUS AND BOSNIA AS AN AUGMENTEE TO 1 RCHA. IN 1995, MWO HERMAN ACCEPTED A COMPONENT TRANSFER TO THE REGULAR FORCE AND WAS POSTED TO W BATTERY, RCAS IN GAGETOWN, NB. IN 1996, MWO HERMAN WAS POSTED TO 2 RCHA IN PETAWAWA, ON.DURING HIS POSTING AT 2 RCHA, HE SERVED IN A VARIETY OF POSITIONS IN ALL OF THE BATTERIES WITHIN THE REGIMENT, AND ONCE AGAIN DEPLOYED TO BOSNIA AND AFGHANISTAN.

IN 2004, MWO HERMAN WAS POSTED TO CFB SUFFIELD, AB AS THE OPERATIONS SUPERVISOR UNTIL 2007. MWO HERMAN RETURNED TO 2 RCHA WHERE HE WAS EMPLOYED AS AN OBSERVATION POST COMMANDER AND A JOINT TERMINAL ATTACK CONTROLLER (JTAC), EVENTUALLY DEPLOYING TO AFGHANISTAN A SECOND TIME ON TASK FORCE 1-10 WHERE HE RECEIVED THE COMMANDER'S COMMENDATION FOR HIS ACTIONS AS A JTAC. UPON HIS RETURN, MWO HERMAN ASSISTED IN THE STAND UP OF THE 81MM MORTAR TROOP AS THE TROOP SERGEANT MAJOR.

IN 2013, MWO HERMAN WAS POSTED TO THE 20TH INDEPENDENT FIELD BATTERY IN LETHBRIDGE, AB IN THE RSS OPERATIONS WARRANT OFFICER ROLE. DURING THIS TIME, MWO HERMAN COMPLETED THE DEFENCE AND SECURITY PROGRAM THROUGH ALGONQUIN COLLEGE. AFTER COMPLETING THE BATTERY SERGEANT MAJOR (BSM) COURSE IN GAGETOWN, MWO HERMAN WAS POSTED TO THE ROYAL MILITARY COLLEGE OF CANADA ATTENDING THE ARMY TECHNICAL WARRANT OFFICERS PROGRAM (ATWOP).


IN 2018, MWO HERMAN WAS PROMOTED TO HIS CURRENT RANK AND UPON COMPLETION OF THE ATWOP, MWO HERMAN WAS POSTED TO THE DIRECTOR OF AMMUNITION EXPLOSIVES MANAGEMENT AND ENGINEERING (DAEME) IN THE NATIONAL CAPITAL REGION AS THE BALLISTICS SUPPORT TECHNICIAN, MASTER GUNNER, AND DIRECTORATE SERGEANT MAJOR OF BOTH DAEME AND NICOLET AMMUNITION TEST FACILITY. HE PARTICIPATED IN NUMEROUS NATO WORKING GROUPS AS THE HEAD OF DELEGATION FOR CANADA DURING HIS POSTING TO DAEME.

IN 2021, MWO HERMAN WAS POSTED ONCE AGAIN TO 2 RCHA AND APPOINTED BSM OF E BTY. HE WAS THEN APPOINTED AS BSM OF HQ AND SERVICES BTY IN THE SUMMER OF 2022. IN 2023, MWO HERMAN APPLIED FOR THE VOCATIONAL REHABILITATION PROGRAM FOR SERVING MEMBERS, AND ON 1 MAY 2023, HE RETURNED TO OTTAWA AND BEGAN WORKING FOR THE DIRECTOR LAND REQUIREMENTS (DLR) WITH THE INDIRECT FIRES MODERNIZATION PROJECT.


