### **Chase the Ace - New Rules**

CHASE THE ACE RULES 2023

Chase the Ace of Hearts Fundraiser

Prior to the start of Chase the Ace a standard deck of 52 cards plus the 2 Jokers will be sealed in envelopes and numbered 1 through 54 and displayed on the board at the Legion Lounge.

The Chase the Ace jackpot will start at a minimum of \$300.

Each week the Jackpot is made up of 30% of the total sales for the week plus all previous amounts in the Jackpot.

Ticket prices are:

\$5 for one ticket,

\$10 for 3 tickets these tickets will be different colours.

Purchasers are to write their name and contact number on each ticket as well as a number relating to the envelopes on the board and deposit the tickets in the locked

draw barrel, which is emptied after each draw.

At no time should the draw barrel be unlocked until just before the draw each Saturday. If a ticket is drawn and does not have an envelope number or if the envelope number is not available on the board, the ticket holder will win the Consolation Prize and will be contacted if not in attendance to choose an envelope to open.

Tickets will be sold Tuesday to Saturday by the Lounge staff with the draw being made Saturday night. Lounge staff will draw the winning ticket and remove the card from the sealed envelope and place the card and ticket back on the board. If the Ace of Hearts is not revealed the winning ticket holder will receive the

Consolation prize for the week and the game continues.

The consolation prize is 20% of the total sales for the week and will be awarded in cash, a signature or initial will be required by the staff awarding the prize.

50% of all ticket sales will be retained by the Lacombe Legion and deposited to the gaming account.

The Jackpot will continue to grow until the Ace of Hearts is revealed or the total dollar amount of tickets sold reaches \$20,000.00 (the AGLC license limit).

\*If the total dollar amount of tickets sold reaches \$17,000 ticket sales will be limited to \$1500 per week until the Ace is revealed or the \$20,000 limit is reached or there are no longer sufficient tickets available to constitute a fair draw the following procedure will occur, the game will be complete:

The first ticket drawn will be awarded the Consolation prize (20°/o) the card inside the envelope that they chose will be revealed, if it is not the Ace of Hearts another ticket will be drawn and the card revealed and so on until the Ace of Hearts is found and the person with that winning ticket will receive the Jackpot.
